

Have you recruited ONE MEMBER, PER COUNCIL, PER MONTH?

In Matthew 9:36-38, we read,
"Jesus...at the sight of the crowds,
his heart was moved with pity for
them because they were troubled
and abandoned, like sheep without
a shepherd. Then he said to his
disciples, 'The harvest is abundant,
but the labourers are few; so ask
the master of the harvest to send
out labourers for his harvest."

In like manner, His Holiness Pope Francis has told Catholics, "we must be on the frontier". Both of these quotes should resonate with the membership of the Knights of Columbus. From the top down, our Supreme Knight Carl. A. Anderson and now joined by State Deputy Ed Shawchuk, you and I are being asked to bring in the harvest, for it is very abundant. One only has to read a paper, the internet or watch the news to see that there are many who are "...troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd". Our job is to bring them home, to invite them back to our Church and then to invite them and their families into the Knights of Colum-

bus. And how are we going to do this? We ask them.

I was just in Alberta for their organizational meeting and listened to a homily about Bill and Bob, two neighbours who liked one another and got on well. One summer Sunday morning, Bill was on his way to the golf course when he saw Bob and asked him to go golfing with him. Bob's reply was, "Sorry, I am going to church today". The next week, the same conversation took place. And for many more Sundays the conversation was the same. Finally, one Sunday after getting the same standard answer from Bob, Bill said, "you know, for at least 20 weeks now I have asked you to go golfing with me and every time you told me you had to go to church. I was just wondering why during all that time, not once did you ask me to go to church with you?" A full 75% of Catholics have returned to the church because a friend asked them to come back. So it is with the Knights, most men will not join us if we do not ask them.

This year we have provided every council with new tools. Grand Knights and District Deputies have been provided with a new, Program Planning Calendar that will help all leaders to plan out their year well in advance. Councils are encouraged to develop the "Power of One" mind set, to look for one new member each month. Even small councils will have success if they work at it. District Deputies are also encouraged to schedule one First Degree each month within their district and in each district, our goal is to develop at least one Star Council.

The State Deputy has put together an excellent team and I for one am excited to work with this team and help make this the best year ever for British Columbia and Yukon. Keep this in mind, God puts us where he wants us and right now, you, as a leader, are exactly where he wants you to be. Don't let Him down, work honestly for Him and work for Him and your Council to the best of your God given abilities. We all need to look in the mirror at the end of the day and ask ourselves, "Did I serve Him to the best of my ability today?"

May God grant you every success this year, your entire State team is here to help you!
