Chancellor

He is charged with strengthening the members' interests in council activities. The chancellor is chairman of the admission committee

Board of Trustees

The board of trustees consists of three members elected by the council and the grand

knight, who serves as chairman of the board. They oversee the work of the financial secretary and treasurer, and with the deputy grand knight serve on the council's retention committee. During council elections, only the three-year trustee is voted on, with the others moving on to become two and one-year trustees, respectively.

Like last year I will make a cardboard sign with 100 blank squares. The squares will be sold for \$5 each. Once they are all sold I will draw the numbers to record on the board. These numbers will make up all the possibilities for scores during the game. They will be based on Eastern Final Champions against Western Final Champions, who will be in the Grey cup.
