## **Grand Knight's Report:**

#### Chancellor

The chancellor has a variety of responsibilities. Primarily, he assists the grand knight and the deputy grand knight in the execution of their duties and oversees the council in both their absences. He is charged with strengthening the members' interests in council activities. The chancellor is chairman of the admission committee

#### **Board of Trustees**

The board of trustees consists of three members elected by the council and the grand knight, who serves as chairman of the board. They oversee the work of the financial secretary and treasurer, and with the deputy grand knight serve on the council's retention committee. During council elections, only the three-year trustee is voted on, with the others moving on to become two and one-year trustees, respectively.

Charity Appeal ticket sales started on October 4<sup>th</sup>. We have ordered 400 books of tickets this year and once again Bro. Gary is our ticket chairman. So please get your tickets from Bro. Gary or me. Our next sale at church will be at the St. Nick's Pancake breakfast on Sunday January 4<sup>th</sup>.

We will also be selling tickets at Royal City Centre January 5<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> and at Lougheed Town Centre January 19<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup>. Once again Rene and Suzanne de Diego will be coordinating the school parents to help us but the knights may be required to cover when the parents are not available.

The cut-off date for sale of the Early bird tickets is January 10<sup>th</sup> and all tickets that have been sold must be returned to Enrico Garrone or left in the Sacristy by **Noon on Sunday January 11<sup>th</sup>** if they are to be returned to St. Francis Xavier Church for the Early Bird Draw. ### Program Directors Report:

As you read my report I trust everyone has had a good Christmas and are possibly preparing to bring in the New Year. Benita and I wish you all the best in 2015. We will be away for Christmas and the New Year, visiting her parents. That will make me unavailable to help with our January Pancake Breakfast, so I ask that all that can please be there **January 4**<sup>th</sup> to help our breakfast chairman Enrico Garrone.

Brothers I have pleasure to announce great things have happened since our last meeting. Our Grey Cup Pool Fund Raiser for St. Michael's food bank was a success raising a total of \$300, \$250 from the pool and \$50 from Brother Pat Welsh. Pat was the winner of the first quarter score and he donated his winnings back to the council. The other winners were Jason May - second quarter

score winner, Gilles Deschenes, winner of the third quarter score, and Tar Rossi winning final score.

Our Christmas Pot Luck Dinner was well attended, with approximately 50 people. We all had a fun night with everyone going home with a small door prize from our request to have each person bring a gift for a gift exchange. With the large crowd we were able to collect a pot of \$320 for the 50/50 draw and the winner being Brother Pat Welsh taking home \$160 and \$160 for deposit at our meeting. Also from our council a small gift of a bottle of white wine was given to Father Swinkles for his dedicated attendance to our dinners and to celebrate Christmas with.

Our Pancake Breakfast with St. Nick was also a huge success in a number of ways. The biggest success for this event was the membership that came out to do the set-up and help at the breakfast, for this I thank all that participated. It was a very busy day for myself making sure everything went well with the pictures with St. Nick and the raffle of our Christmas Hampers. In conjunction with our breakfast the ladies auxiliary had a great day of fund raising with their bake sale. Special thanks to our St. Nick, Tom McClosky, breakfast chairman Enrico Garrone, our photographer Moreno Rossi and his help. Also thanks to Kay Crocock and Eddie Ennis for their help registering the people for the pictures, Robert Murphie arranging the purchase and delivery of Christmas trees, and not to mention Benita McLean for her help selling raffle tickets for the Christmas hampers. The Pictures with St. Nick collected \$216 for deposit into Knights account. The breakfast sales were \$921 less \$604.69 in expenses for a profit of \$316.31. Make note the trees are donated to St. Michael's for the Parish Centre and Church decorations for Christmas.

Our Christmas Hamper sales were started the week of our Breakfast with St. Nick and draw was made after the **noon** mass December 21st. A deposit of \$450 was made at our last meeting and another deposit of \$360 will be made at our **January 13<sup>th</sup>** meeting or sooner. That will bring a total of \$810 raised from our Hamper sales. Along with the \$300 in Grey Cup Pool fund raiser this money is a fund raiser for St. Michael's food bank, for a total of \$1110 raised.

FYI, December 22<sup>nd</sup> was the delivery day for approximately 60 Christmas hampers to the poor. These hampers consisted of two boxes of nonperishable and a turkey so you can imagine St. Michael's contribution to the poor for the entire year must be amazing. Please remember that the money we raise for the food bank in turn relieves the need for money in other areas of our Parish. The winners of the Christmas Hampers were the Champion Family getting the Bosa Hamper, Michelle Biajini, the Save-on Hamper, and Ellen Kerr the biggest hamper from Thrifty Foods. We thank everyone that participated in selling and buying tickets.
