## Program Director's Report:

Worthy Brothers and your families, Benita and I wish everyone a very special and holy Easter season.

This is the time for us to sacrifice a little with days of fast and abstinence, or we may substitute with special acts of charity or piety. With that said please consider our endeavors to feed St. Michael's parishioners pancakes, raise funds for Special Olympics, support the clergy with pennies from Heaven, ushering at Mass, participating as a choir member, or just doing what we can around our parish are small ways that we show our gratitude to Christ for his sacrifice to us but we should always consider more.

This Sunday we have a pancake breakfast that will require much support from our members, so please come out to make this day a good time for everyone.

Other coming events that need Knights support are first the Clergy Dinner sponsored by St. Peters council 1283. The dinner is a small recognition to the clergy for all they do for our parishes. All priests, Bishops, Deacons and sisters in our area are invited free of charge as a sign of the Knights support to them. To help defray the cost to St. Peters knights, all councils are required to send two council members per priest. In the past, members that have attended have taken their wives. The Fourth Degree from each council in our district also show their support by serving of the meal. This is an opportunity to get to know our clergy a bit better, so think about it and call our Grand Knight John Cabana to advise your interest.

Our Pennies for Heaven campaign is another way the Knights support our clergy. The funds raised are presented to the clergy at our State Convention at end of April. Each individual council makes a

presentation and a total is made from all councils in B.C./Yukon for distribution by the clergy for all their needs. Our council asks that each member save their change and turn it in at our April meeting for counting. If you cannot attend the meeting I ask to pass your contribution on to a fellow Knight that can turn it in or give me a call at 604-939-5793 and I will make arrangements to receive it.

In April as well we have scheduled the 10th as the day for our walk for Special Olympics. This is a fund raiser that our council has done for the past 4-5 years. Most our efforts are for our school and parish. This is one way we can commit to our community. It is a very easy walk with little grade changes to deal with. We walk approximately 6 kms, in Coquitlam around the Como Lake area. The big challenge is to actually collect pledges for the walk. The Special Olympics are in this case for the mentally challenged and is something that a lot of people don't know much about as they are not as well advertised as are the Paralympics. Again all the funds will be collected and turned in at our April meeting so a cheque can be issued by our council and presented to a director of Special Olympics at the Knights Convention by our Grand Knight. Special Olympics will issue a tax receipt for donations \$20 and over. Now the important thing is that those that participate come to our meeting March 8th and get a pledge form, we will only have one month to get pledges and collect the money. The more people we have the more we should raise.

The last thing I would like to discuss is the Parish Auction April 30th. Our council participates by looking after the bar needs. I thank Gilles Deschenes for taking on duties of organizing our part to make this event a success. If anyone is interested in helping please let me or Gilles know and we can assign a job to you as a bartender. We typically only need a few for serving but the cleanup will work better with a few more.

Last in closing please note there will not be a Pot Luck Dinner this March but it will return on April 2nd.
