Program Director's Report:

Welcome back Worthy Brothers to our Knights of Columbus new term for 2016 / 2017, I hope that everyone had a pleasurable and enjoying summer with your families. Our council has had some success at recruiting members to take responsibilities as executive members of our council. As everyone knows our long time Financial Secretary Dave Fremantle has elected to not take that position for another year. It is with great sadness that we accept Dave's resignation and thank him for his past 25 years in the position of Financial Secretary for our council. As you can imagine we will have very large shoes to fill. Dave did his job with dedication and also made our council operate with great success, addressing all our concerns and that of State and Supreme councils. I personally thank Dave for his help when I was Grand Knight of St Michael's council. Our council will not be able to continue if this position is not filled. Now that said please remember that all positions on our council's executive are not by any means full time jobs. They are done by volunteers in every council and every council is operated in the same manner. If you are approached to take a job please consider these two things, first these positions are in many ways a means of learning things to better yourself and two they are positions that give us opportunities to work/help our fellow parishioners and our church/community.

During this summer we did have a group of Knights do some work around the parish centre such as build a new patio stone walk way. This walkway gives access to the patio in the back of the centre from the entrance to the Parish Centre Hall in the basement. It improves access for the elderly and physically impaired by not having to walk on the grass that was there previously. At the time that was done we also had members working cleaning the Parish Centre gutters which, because of the difficulty to do that work, had started to grow many weeds. For some this weed garden may mean that Catholics are very conscious of the environment and promote this type of roof top garden but our Monsignor Rossi could not agree that invasive weeds should be part of his environment. The job was not completed at that time because of the effort to get up on the roof without proper harness and rope to tie a person off to eliminate any chance of a fall. There is work on St. Michael's school scheduled and a lift truck will be used which will also give the Knights the ability to access those gutters that could not be done and thereby completing the job. Unfortunately I will be away the last two weeks of August and not there to help with that or with the Parish Picnic so I am looking for help to do the things that I would have normally been a big part of.

Sept 10th we will have a Pot Luck Dinner in the Parish Centre. The set up will go back to our original time of 10:00 AM as I could not get much help to set up for the dinners at 5:00 PM.

Pot Luck Dinners are a means for the membership and our friends to meet and socialize together. All that is required for you to attend is make and bring a dish that will feed yourself along with a couple others. Remember that you are not feeding everyone and when many attend there is always a great selection of different foods that can be enjoyed by most. This is a great way new members can

get to know others in our council and parish, so come out and join us. Please note that we do have coffee and tea but if you would like to enjoy a bottle of wine bring what you like.
