FYI for those that missed last month's meeting, Monsignor Rossi made a request of the Knights. It was to have a look at the stairs facing north off the old rectory front entrance deck as they are reportedly unsafe and ready to collapse. I took it upon myself to survey this situation and found that they were in very poor condition, but also found the deck was in need of repair as well. I decided that the weather conditions would not support a full on repair for everything. With Alain Custeau's help we did a temporary repair to the stairs with the understanding that down the road we will do a full repair. The stairs are safe to use now and Monsignor is happy. Later when weather is good for painting, we will have to tear up the deck, replace the plywood and recover with vinyl covering. The stairs will need new stringers and a complete set of runners. If anyone knows of someone capable of doing the covering of the deck, please advise me as I believe that will be the most difficult part of this repair.

Our Pot Luck Dinner in Feb was nice to see everyone who attended. We all had a good time and a great meal. We look forward to March 3rd for our next one. In February our 50/50 raised \$150 thanks to Brother Stan March, who donated his winnings of \$75 back to our council.
