Last year our council sold 260 books and we will receive a rebate of \$2,774.20 which we have apply for and voted on to go to our parish food bank, as in past years. Another thank-you to Brother Terry Duggan, with help from Brothers Tarcisio Rossi, Alan Wardle, and myself for completing the semi-annual audit (Jan – Jun, 2020) which was submitted August 15, having been reviewed by our trustees.

This was due to many efforts of our knights in completing 4 programs in each category; Faith, Family, Community, and Life, as reported on the SP7 – Columbian Award Application. Also we achieved our membership growth quota as a result of our successful membership drive and subsequent exemplification of new members; thanks to Brother Enrico, Brother Alan, and others who attended these degrees. For the Insurance requirements, some of our members attended the on-line Benefits presentation to satisfy this requirement. Congratulations all!
