Program Director's Report:

Charity Appeal: This year's Charity Appeal, one of our few fundraisers this year, began Oct. 18th and ends Jan. 29, 2022, 7 pm.; Early Bird Draw is Saturday, Dec. 4, 2021, 7:15 pm. Sales will be on-line only again this year, and for St. Michael's the link is: www.kofcdraw.net/C9246. Tickets are \$3 each.

Prizes are all cash totaling \$135,000:

Note that all tickets must be sold within British Columbia and the buyer must be 19 or over. There are only 200,000 tickets for sale this year, after which sales will be closed.
