#### Parish Council Update:

Plans are being made to replace church windows, starting with the basement, to reduce heat loss. Then the furnace and heating system will be reviewed.

- Recondition the pews and replace current floorcovering.

### Program Director's Report:

Charity Appeal: This year's Charity Appeal, one of our few fundraisers this year, began Oct. 18<sup>th</sup> and ended Jan. 29, 2022. Our council received a commission cheque for \$373.80. Due to lower than expected sales, there are no rebates this year. At our last council meeting, we voted to top up this amount to \$400, and donate \$200 to the Ukraine through the Knights of Columbus, and \$200 to our parish food bank. To support the needs of our diocesan Bishop's, there will be another on-line 50/50 raffle, July 1, 2022 to Aug. 13, 2022. More details coming soon.

**Pancake Breakfasts:** We have not started this yet for safety concerns due to the pandemic. We will keep an eye on the COVID numbers and lifting of restrictions, i.e. vaccination passports for restaurants, etc., and try to open this up again as soon as possible. We also need a new coordinator, preferably with Food Safe, for this activity. Let me (Gary) or GK John Cabana know if you can help with this task.

With spring approaching we are looking at a fundraising campaign I hope all worthy members participate in: our annual "**Pennies for Heaven**" fundraiser.
